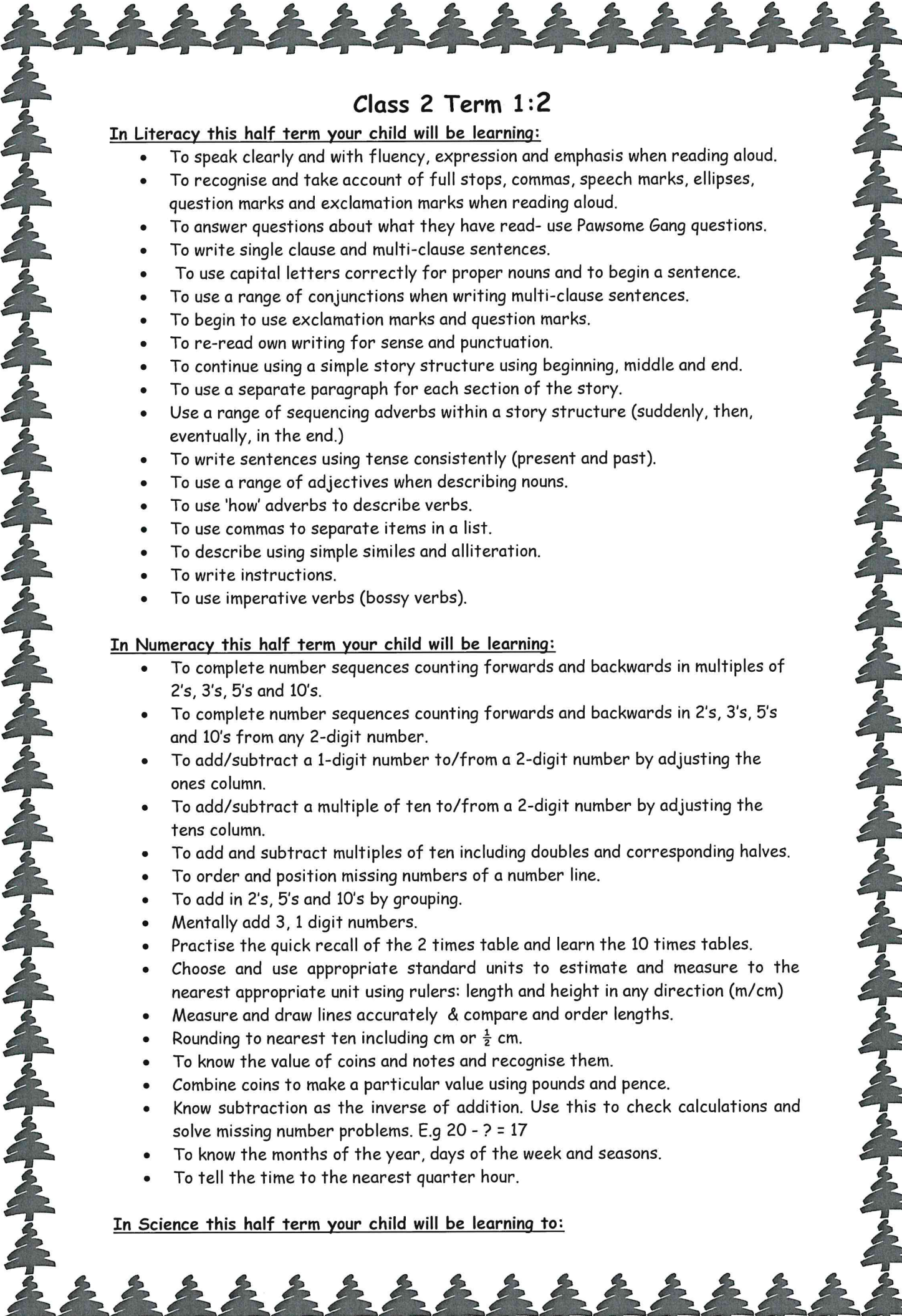




Class 2 Term 1:2

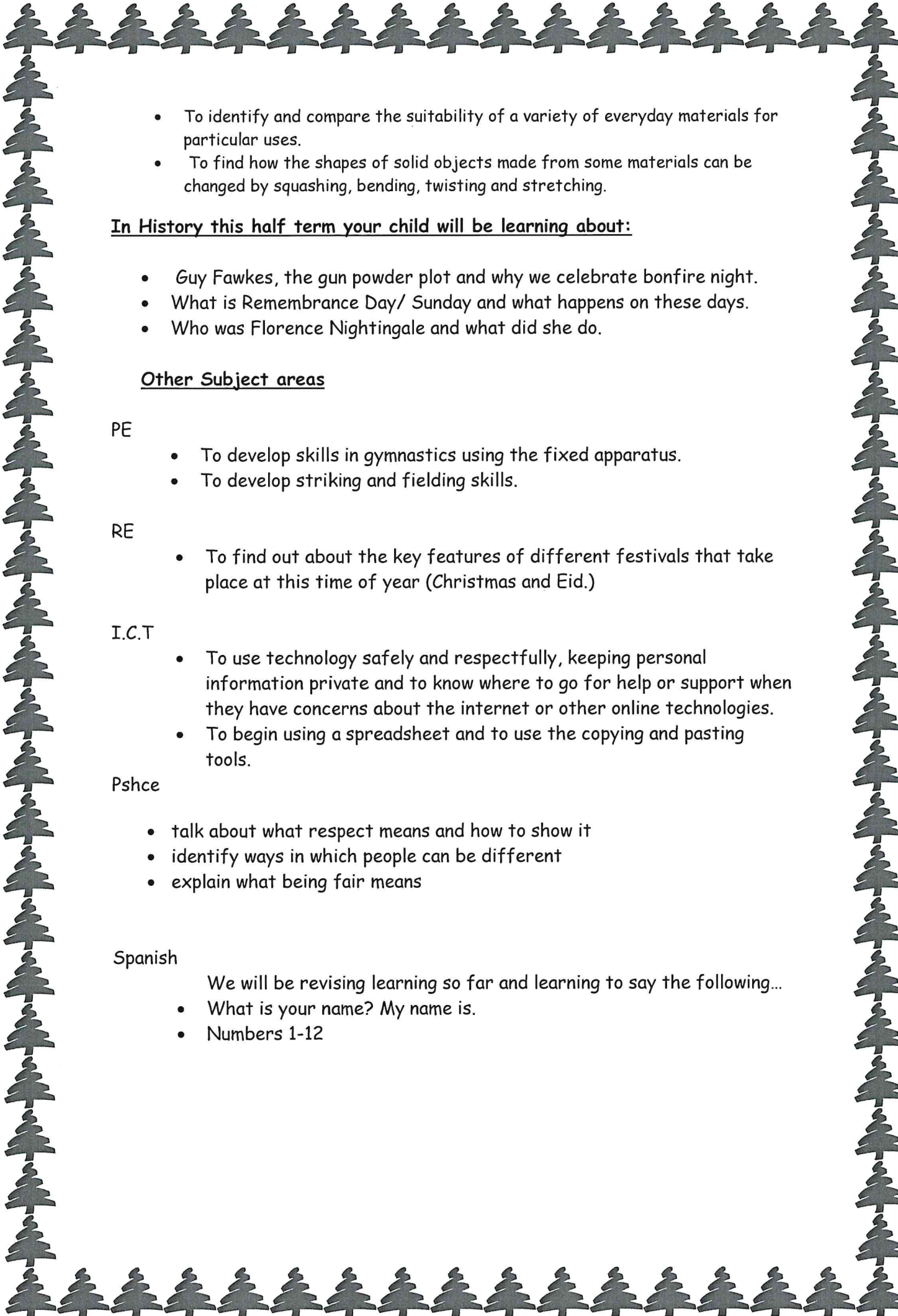
In Literacy this half term your child will be learning:

- To speak clearly and with fluency, expression and emphasis when reading aloud.
- To recognise and take account of full stops, commas, speech marks, ellipses, question marks and exclamation marks when reading aloud.
- To answer questions about what they have read- use Pawsome Gang questions.
- To write single clause and multi-clause sentences.
- To use capital letters correctly for proper nouns and to begin a sentence.
- To use a range of conjunctions when writing multi-clause sentences.
- To begin to use exclamation marks and question marks.
- To re-read own writing for sense and punctuation.
- To continue using a simple story structure using beginning, middle and end.
- To use a separate paragraph for each section of the story.
- Use a range of sequencing adverbs within a story structure (suddenly, then, eventually, in the end.)
- To write sentences using tense consistently (present and past).
- To use a range of adjectives when describing nouns.
- To use 'how' adverbs to describe verbs.
- To use commas to separate items in a list.
- To describe using simple similes and alliteration.
- To write instructions.
- To use imperative verbs (bossy verbs).

In Numeracy this half term your child will be learning:

- To complete number sequences counting forwards and backwards in multiples of 2's, 3's, 5's and 10's.
- To complete number sequences counting forwards and backwards in 2's, 3's, 5's and 10's from any 2-digit number.
- To add/subtract a 1-digit number to/from a 2-digit number by adjusting the ones column.
- To add/subtract a multiple of ten to/from a 2-digit number by adjusting the tens column.
- To add and subtract multiples of ten including doubles and corresponding halves.
- To order and position missing numbers of a number line.
- To add in 2's, 5's and 10's by grouping.
- Mentally add 3, 1 digit numbers.
- Practise the quick recall of the 2 times table and learn the 10 times tables.
- Choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure to the nearest appropriate unit using rulers: length and height in any direction (m/cm)
- Measure and draw lines accurately & compare and order lengths.
- Rounding to nearest ten including cm or $\frac{1}{2}$ cm.
- To know the value of coins and notes and recognise them.
- Combine coins to make a particular value using pounds and pence.
- Know subtraction as the inverse of addition. Use this to check calculations and solve missing number problems. E.g $20 - ? = 17$
- To know the months of the year, days of the week and seasons.
- To tell the time to the nearest quarter hour.

In Science this half term your child will be learning to:

- 
- To identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials for particular uses.
 - To find how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

In History this half term your child will be learning about:

- Guy Fawkes, the gun powder plot and why we celebrate bonfire night.
- What is Remembrance Day/ Sunday and what happens on these days.
- Who was Florence Nightingale and what did she do.

Other Subject areas

PE

- To develop skills in gymnastics using the fixed apparatus.
- To develop striking and fielding skills.

RE

- To find out about the key features of different festivals that take place at this time of year (Christmas and Eid.)

I.C.T

- To use technology safely and respectfully, keeping personal information private and to know where to go for help or support when they have concerns about the internet or other online technologies.
- To begin using a spreadsheet and to use the copying and pasting tools.

- talk about what respect means and how to show it
- identify ways in which people can be different
- explain what being fair means
