Physical Geography Disadvantages:

Volcanoes - can be dangerous if they erupt

Rivers - can flood and destroy houses and crops

Mountains - really high mountains can have avalanches

Sea - can be very dangerous - tidal waves, tsunamis etc.

Plates tectonics - can move to create earthquakes.

Physical Geography Advantages:

Volcanoes - look impressive. Lots of scientific studies.

Rivers - Provide transport, water for farm land, water for houses.

Mountains - great scenery, walking

Sea - transport, tidal power, swimming in.

Human geography Disadvantages:

Roads - bad for the environment - car emissions. Look ugly. Spoil the landscape.

Buildings - spoil the landscape, block the sun, use lots of cement which is really bad for the environment.

Human geography Advantages:

Roads - transport goods and people.

Buildings - provide places to live and work. Also hospitals.

Some buildings look architecturally great.
