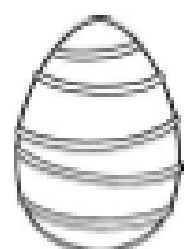
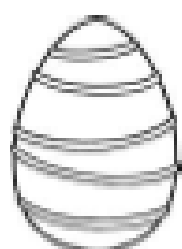
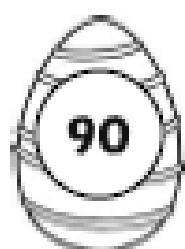
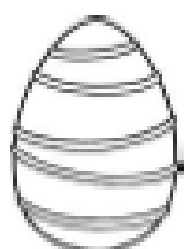
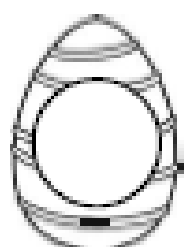
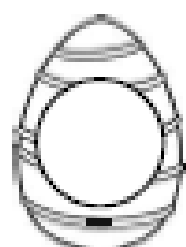
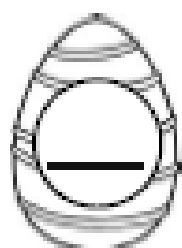
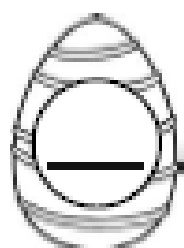
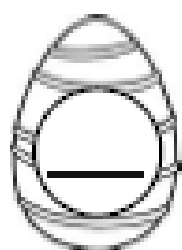
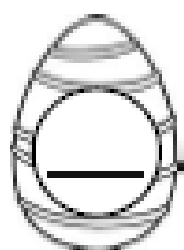


Easter Egg Maze
