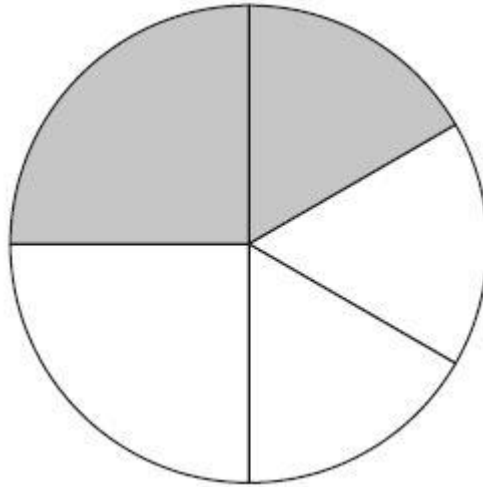
Tick two shapes that have $\frac{3}{4}$ shaded.

What fraction of the whole circle is **not** shaded?

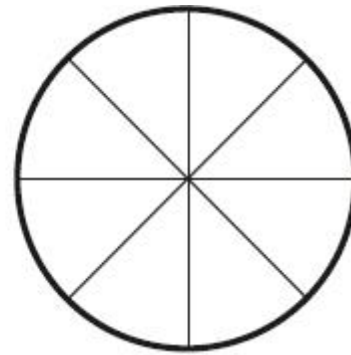
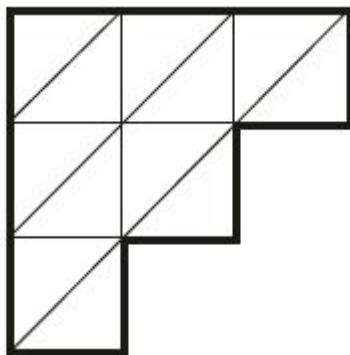
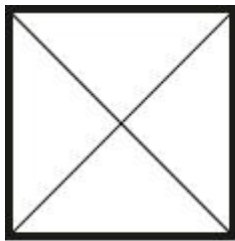
