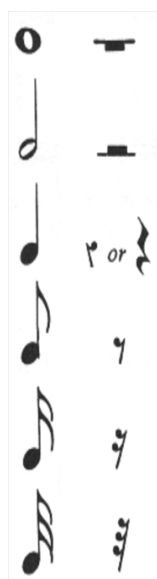




Time Signature

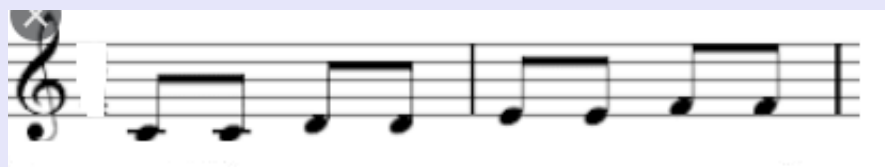

Look at the sheet of music.

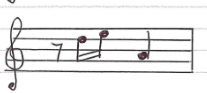
Put the time signature for the first examples.

Work out each time signature.

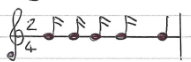
