Cautiously, Lily walks into her room, trying not to be seen or heard by her teachers.

Malkin dives into the escape pod and waves at John in desperation.



Past tense

John pushed Malkin towards the door.



Lily was shouted at by the teacher.

The silver airship gained on Dragonfly.

Turn these sentences into the present tense.

Lana walked to the shop and bought some treats.

Josh ate the Skittles!

Freddie bowled three people out at cricket and caught two other people out.



Turn these into the past tense.

Paige cheers as she scores the winning goal at ice-hockey.

We have looked at an example of a narrative that uses flashbacks. We have also looked at using higher level punctuation in our writing.

Today, you are going to write a piece of narrative with a flashback in for Lily (from Cogheart).

Think about what she could be doing in the present tense e.g. balancing books whilst reading a penny dreadful.

Think about what her flashback might be and how it might be triggered e.g. one of the images might remind her of her mother and then she is transported back to a time when her mother was still alive.
