- 1) Maddison baked 3 trays of 36 buns. How many buns did she bake?
- 2) Sebastian measured the perimeter of a regular hexagon, each side was 29cm. What was the total of all the sides?
- 3) Millie read 19 pages of her book every night for 5 days. How many pages did she read?
- 4) Charlie pedals his bike 27 KM every day for 4 days. How far did he ride in total?
- 5) If iced buns are 68p each and Lucy buys 3, how much does she need?
- 6) Reggie had 34 conkers. Jude had 3 times as many. How many conkers does Jude have?
- 7) 26 sharks feasted on some fish. If each shark ate 7 fish, how many fish were eaten?
- 8) Isabelle grew 4 rows of cabbages. There were 32 cabbages in a row. How many cabbages altogether?
- 9) Twenty nine frogs are all dissected into three parts in a Science lesson. By the end of the lesson how many different lumps of frog were there?
- 10) Eight aliens landed at the North pole. Each alien had 37 laser cannons. How many laser canons were there altogether?
