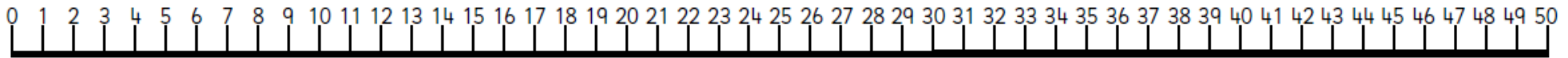


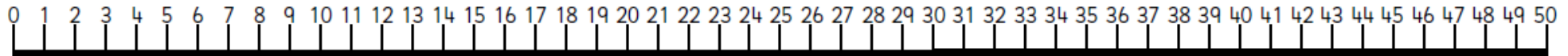
Comparing multiplication tables - Twos and Fours
