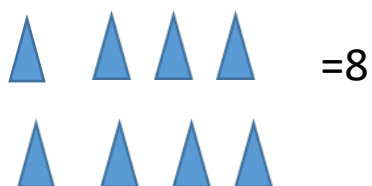

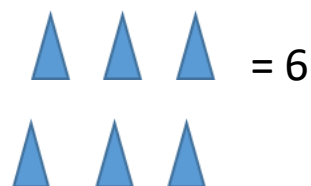
Imagine each answer is put on the scales, which number is greater or do they balance?
