

Teacher notes

Children will select a scenario card and complete the pictogram using either the pictogram symbols provided or concrete manipulatives. They must choose a relevant key based on the numbers provided and remember to include the key on their pictogram. It is important that children remember to line their symbols up. Alternatively, this activity can be drawn in books.

DEVELOPING ★ ☆ ☆

Pictograms will be provided with given headings and labels.
Children may need prompts and may only use keys and symbols representing 2.

SECURE ★ ★ ☆

Pictograms will be provided with given headings and labels.
Children use the numbers to determine whether the keys and symbols represent 2, 5 or 10.

MASTERY ★ ★ ★

Pictograms will be provided requiring children to fill in the headings and labels.
Children use the numbers to determine whether the keys and symbols represent 2, 5 or 10.
