- Reading and Writing Tasks this week includes:
 - The next **News Four Stories** newspaper articles and comprehensions.
 - **Reading and Writing Tasks The Victory Dogs** - Extracts followed by a range Reading and Writing activities based on Megan Rix's book 'The Victory Dogs'. In this book, the 1940s Blitz is portrayed as we follow the fortunes of a lost dog.
 - **Reading and Writing Tasks The Great Escape** - Extracts followed by Reading and Writing activities based on Megan Rix's book 'The Great Escape'. In this book, we follow the fortunes of 3 pets on a journey to find their family who have been evacuated during WW2.
 - **Reading and Writing Task First News WW2 Newspaper** - Read a range of Newspaper Articles from WW2 about animal heroes and then have a go at writing your own article too.
