Statement



Statement: A piece of information- a fact.
e.g A animal with a webbed footprint.

Command: An instruction to do something. (Includes an imperative/bossy verb.)
e.g Help us now.

Question: Start with a question word, ends with a question mark and requires an answer.
e.g Have you seen a creature like this?

Exclamation: Starts with 'how' or 'what' and exclaims something surprising. Can end with an exclamation mark. Does not require an answer.
e.g What a mystery this is!

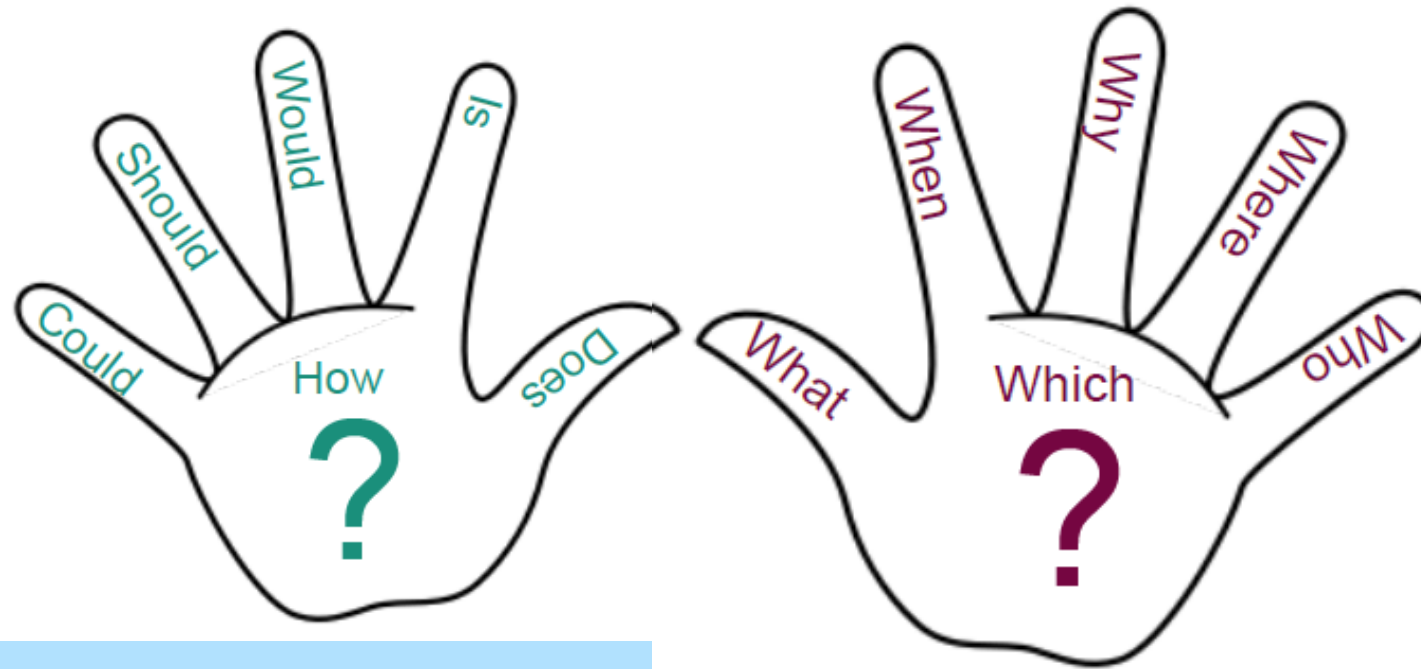

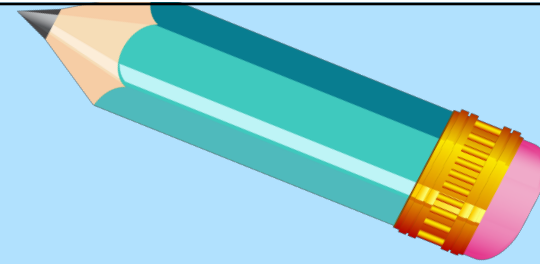

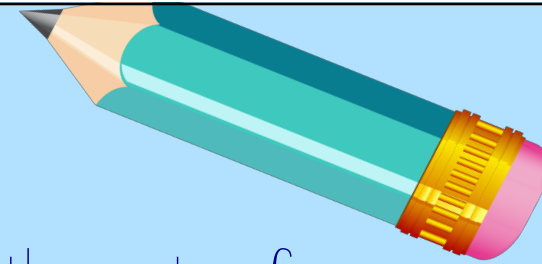
