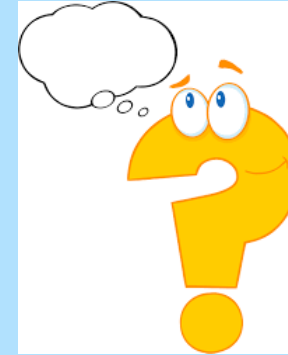
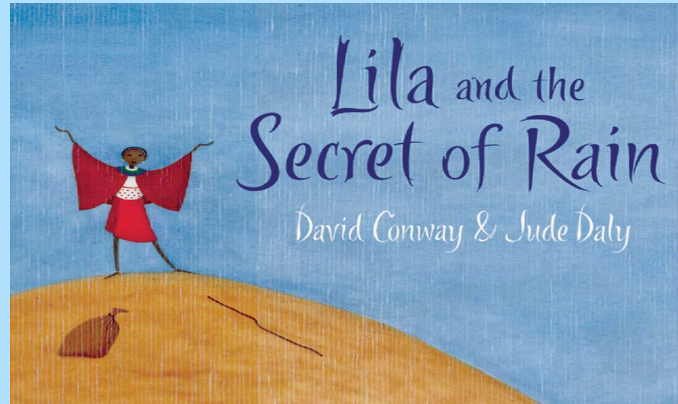
W.I.L.F:
