

Divide by 10

Children will use place value counters to divide by 10.

They will create the total with place value 10 counters. This will allow them to visually see how many tens are in the number.

They can then draw this as a representation in their book or stick place value counters in to show this, which will allow them to structure their calculation.

Developing children can use the stem sentences and calculations provided to help them.

Example:

1) How many 10s in 30 ?

10 10 10 $\div 10 = 3$ ✓

$30 \div 10 = 3$ ✓

There are 3 tens in 30. ✓

2) How many 10s in 50 ?

10 10 10 10 10 $\div 10 = 5$ ✓

$50 \div 10 = 5$ ✓

There are 5 tens in 50. ✓
