An expanded noun phrase is when you use an adjective to describe a noun.

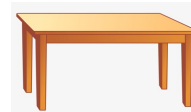
e.g. brown dog

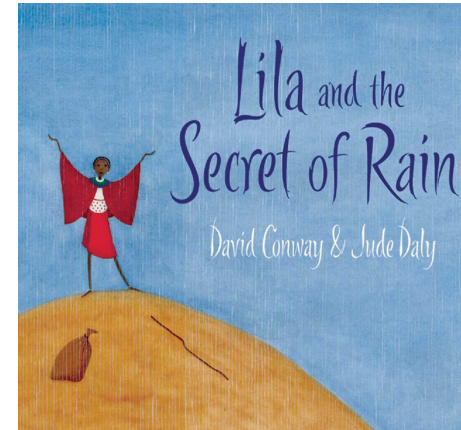

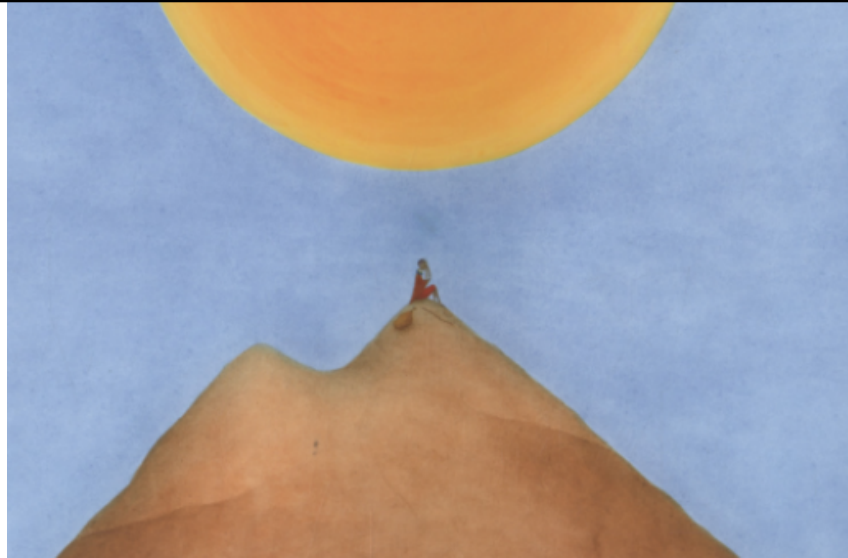

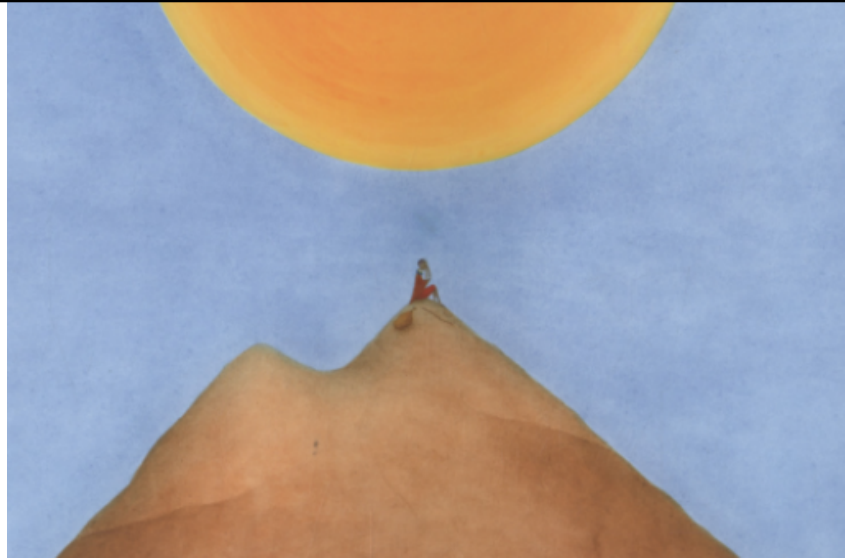
My example

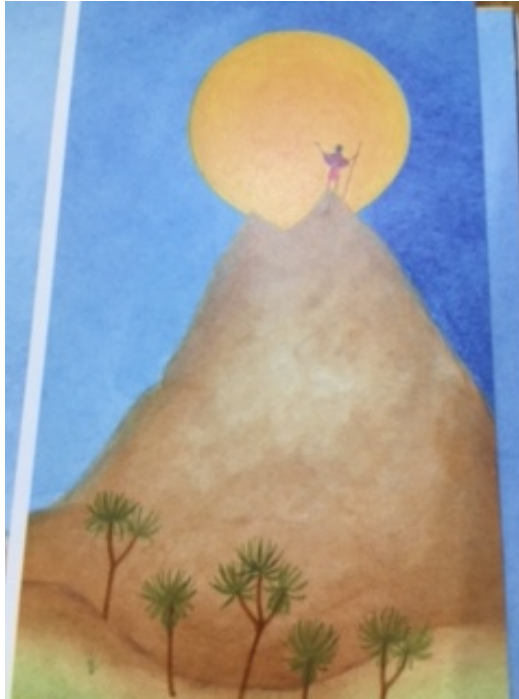
