An adjective describes a noun (naming word)

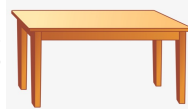
e.g. brown dog

wooden table



What is an *expanded noun phrase*?



An expanded noun phrase is when you use an adjective to describe a noun.

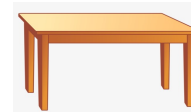
e.g. brown dog

What is a simile?

simile: a description where you compare one thing with another thing of a different kind

e.g the boy ran as fast as a rocket

the diamonds twinkled as brightly as the stars

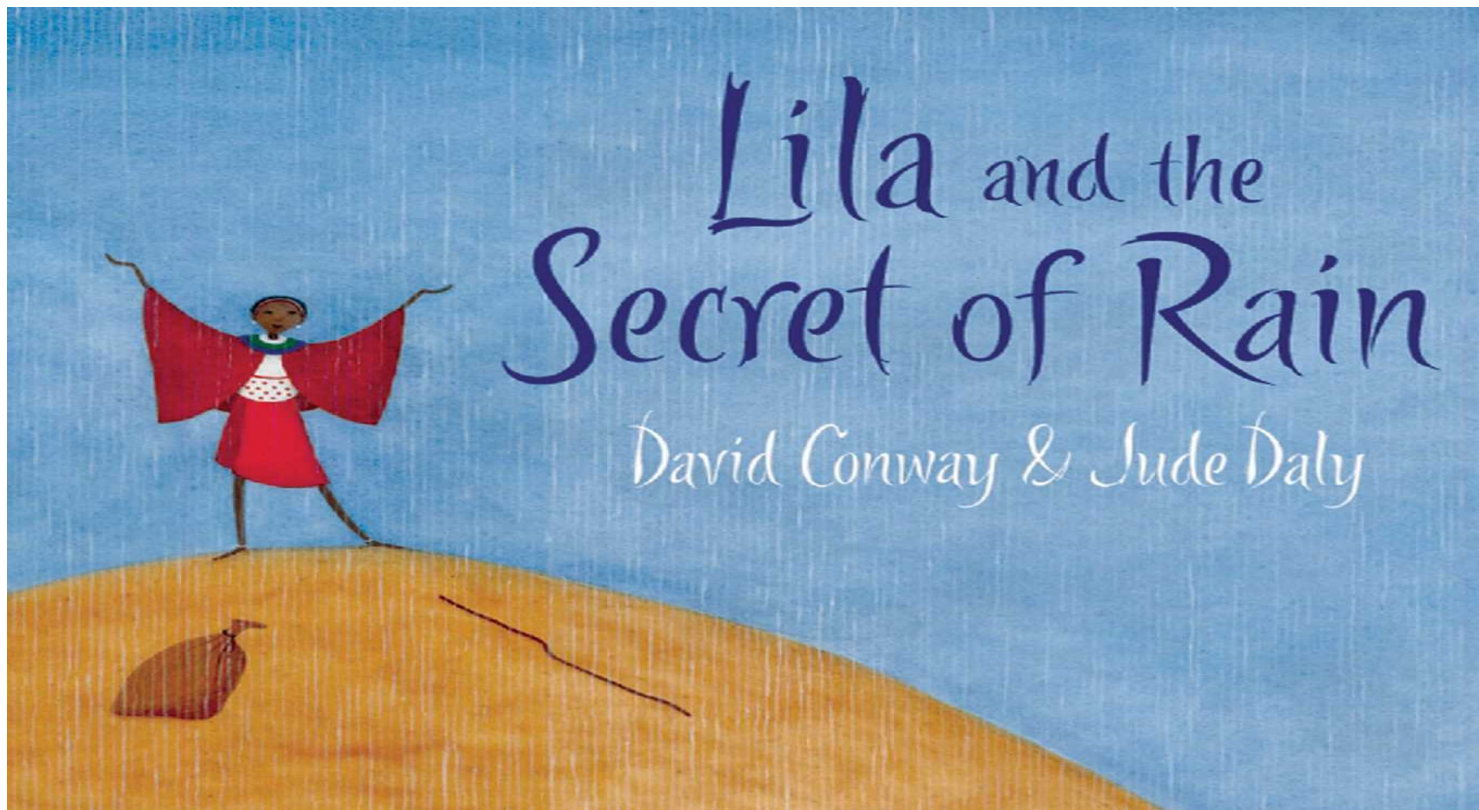
the wind howled like a wolf
