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Maths

- This week we are looking at Statistics and Graphs
- We will also be reviewing learning through more reasoning and arithmetic tests once more so that all skills learnt throughout the year can be practiced and refreshed.
- This week, once again, in the **Maths Tasks** pack I have set links to BBC Bitesize and White Rose Maths on Statistics and Graphs plus some extra tasks and challenges, so please choose which works best for your learning.
- There is a **Maths Statistics Knowledge Organiser** to help if needed.
- Please work through Arithmetic Test 3 and 4 - Please take up to 25 minutes for each test (**Maths Y4 Arithmetic Full Test 3 and 4**). Please let me know your scores and if you struggled on a question and I can try to explain it via a Class Dojo message.
- Have a go at **Maths Y4 Reasoning Set 1 Test B** - You can have 50 minutes to complete this test. What will you score?
- As always, please continue working on your times tables and try and improve your score and time using the **Times Tables 5 Minute Frenzy** tests.

Writing

- This week you will be researching, planning and writing a Diary Entry about a child being evacuated.
