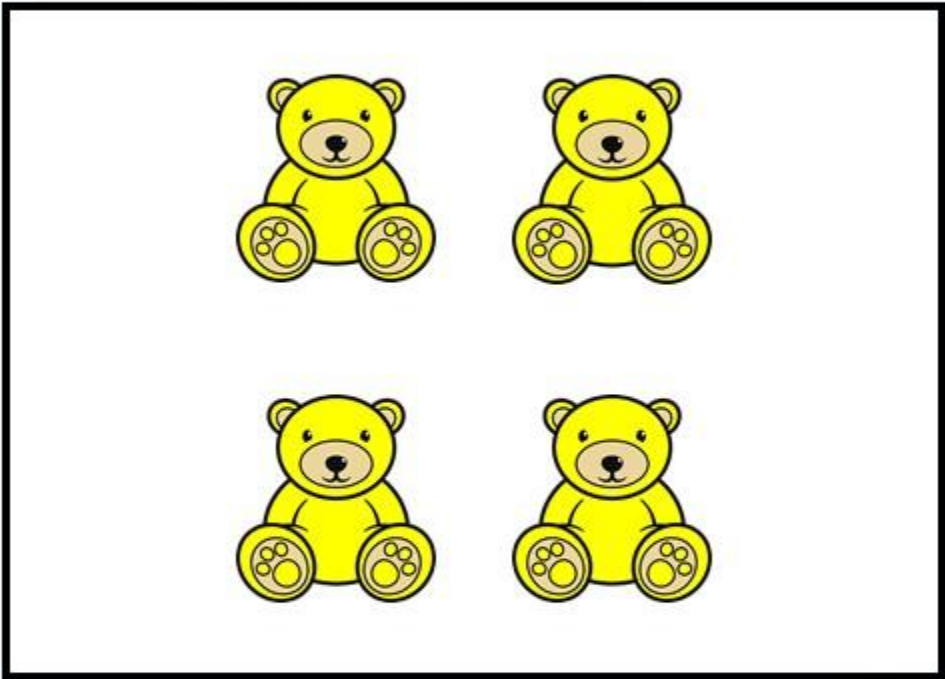
No, Kat has not shared them correctly.

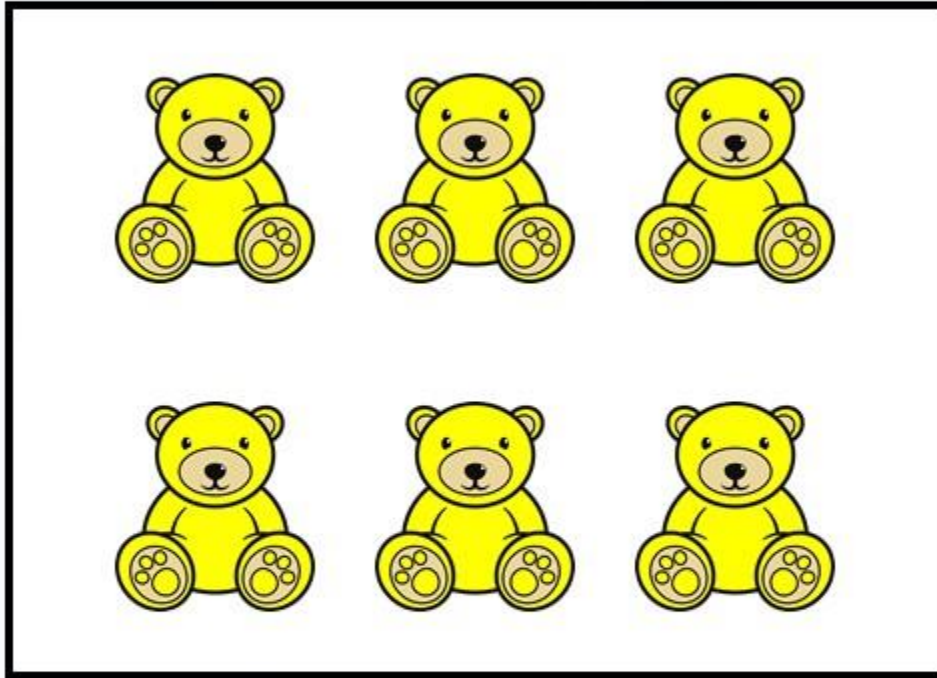

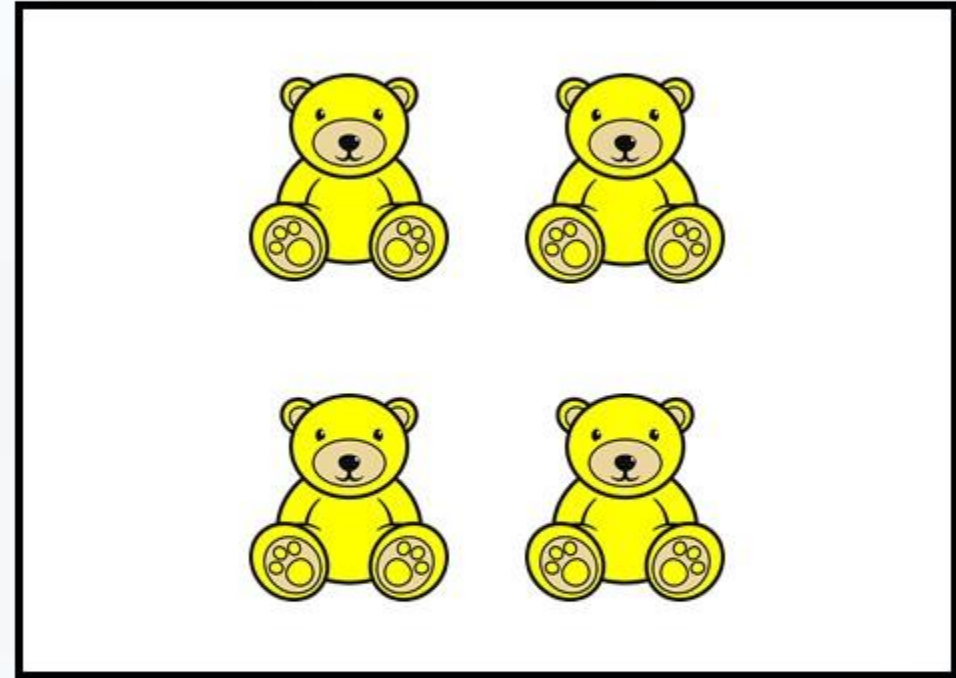
