

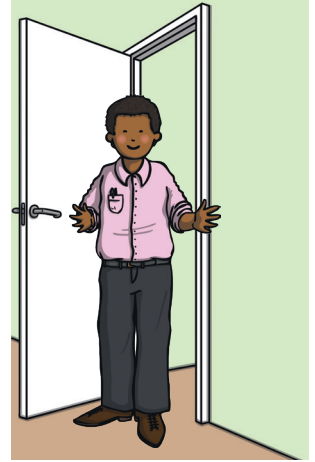
Q4: Find and copy **two** words which describe the flakes falling from the sky.
