



What does it mean?

discreetly: in a careful manner, in order to keep something unnoticed

stealthily: in a very careful, cautious manner not to be seen or heard

subtly: in a way that is so fine or delicate as to be difficult to notice

surreptitiously: in a way that attempts to avoid notice or attention; secretively

What does it mean?

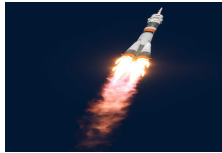
simile: a description where you compare one thing with another thing of a different kind

e.g the boy ran as fast as a rocket

the diamonds twinkled as brightly as the stars



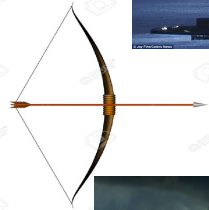

What does it mean?

adjective: a describing word which describes a noun

e.g the red coat

the book was wonderful



Let's remind ourselves of the shot/still from the video when the cheetah unleashes his claw.



Let's think of adjectives to describe the claw.



curved sharp lethal

piercing needle-like lethal

deadly vicious curved hooked,

dangerous serrated razor-sharp

painful



The Hunt.

To write your own paragraph with the sub-heading the hunt. Use all the skills you have been taught this lesson and structure it as shown in the modelled write.

Sentence 1- Use a how adverb to describe the first stage of the hunt 'the stalk'.

Sentence 2- Use a simile to describe how the cheetah moves to catch the prey.

Sentence 3- Use 2 adjectives in the end position to describe the cheetah's claw when he unleashes it.
