with 'g' and 'j'.**



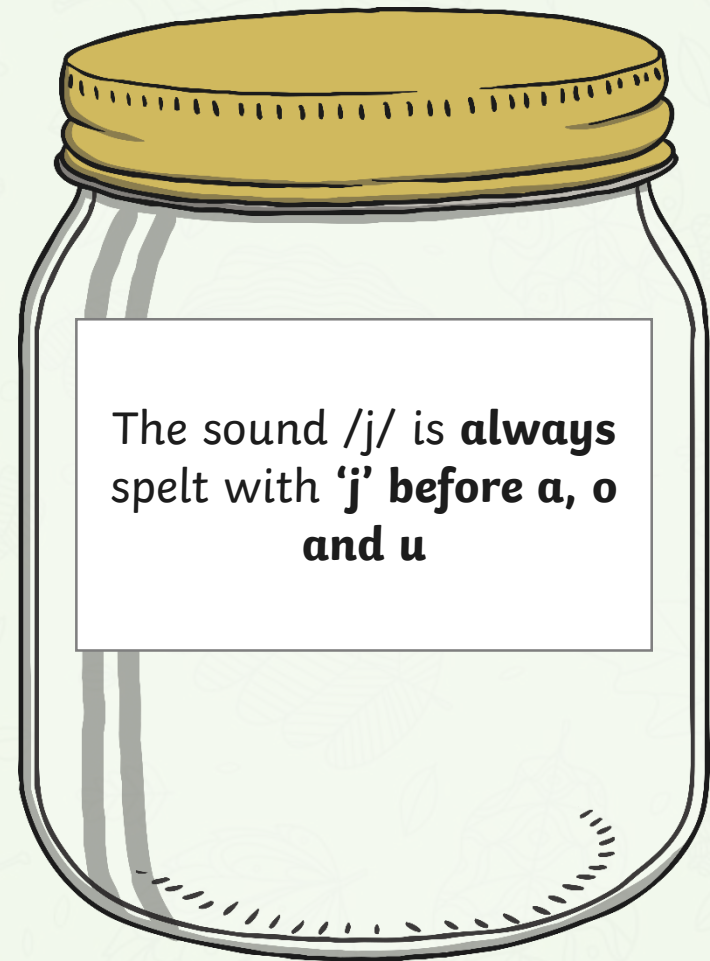
Watch Out!

We have looked at the phoneme /j/ spelt with '-dge' and '-ge' at the end of words last week. Can you remember the rules? Look at the boxes below to remind you.

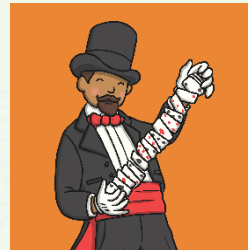
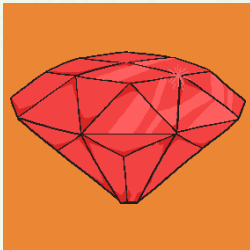
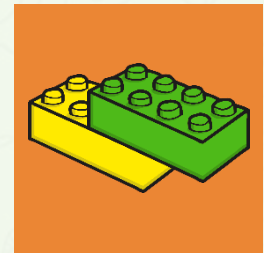
At the end of a word, the /j/ sound is spelt '**-dge**' after the *short* vowel sounds /a/, /e/, /i/, /o/, /u/

Watch out! After all other sounds (vowels or consonants) the /j/ sound is spelt '**-ge**' at the end of a word.

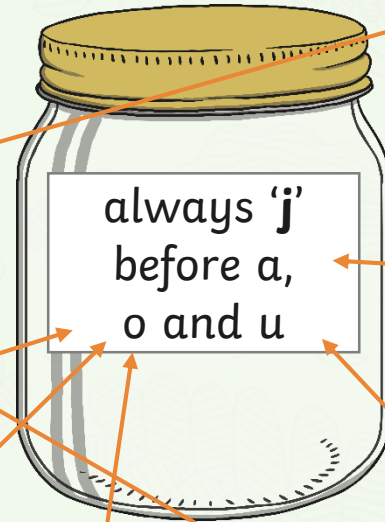
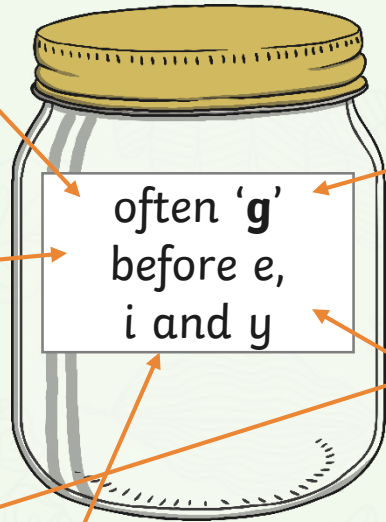
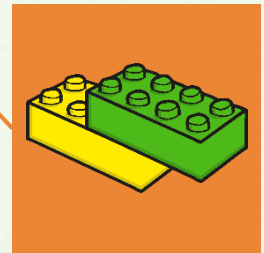
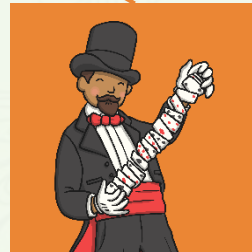
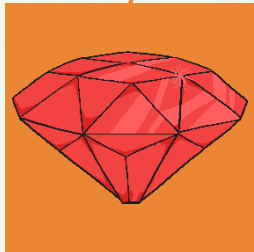
Let's look at two more rules for spelling the sound /j/:
