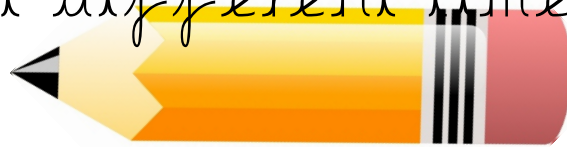
W.A.L.T: To write effective sentences for

We are going to continue to write our non-chronological report about cheetahs. We are going to write a paragraph to describe the cheetah's habitat (the savannah) at different times of the day.



What is an adjective?

An adjective describes a noun (naming word)

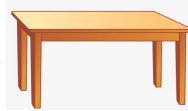
e.g. brown dog



old house



wooden table



We are going to collect some adjectives and descriptive phrases to describe the sun rising on the savannah.

- *cicadas (suh-kaa-duhz) hum gently in the distance
- *animals stretched their limbs ready for a new day

What is a time adverbial?

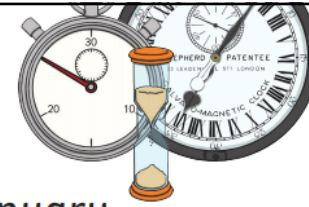
An adverb that describe when something happened.

What is onomatopoeia?

Onomatopoeia is the process of creating a word that phonetically imitates, resembles, or suggests the sound that it describes. e.g BANG! sizzle, whoosh!

Common onomatopoeias include animal noises such as "oink", "meow", "roar" and "squeak".



We are going to imagine we are on the savannah at night and think of noises we could hear using onomatopoeia.

2nd sentence- At dawn... followed by a descriptive sentence to describe dawn on the savannah, refer to word bank on slide.

3rd sentence- A time adverbial to describe midday, followed by what the cheetah would do at that time of the day- refer to word bank on slide.

4th sentence- Start with conjunction - while, whilst or as, followed by what the cheetah would do at that time of the day and some noises he hears (onomatopoeia) - refer to word bank on slides).
