- For names of people/pets e.g. Clare, Daniel, Fido including titles
- e.g. Mrs Bradshaw, Mr Smith, Miss Brown, Dr Haigh
- Places e.g. Barnsley
- Days of the week and months of the year e.g. Monday 11th January
- The pronoun I
- Religious celebrations e.g. Christmas, Easter, Eid, Rosh Hashanah
