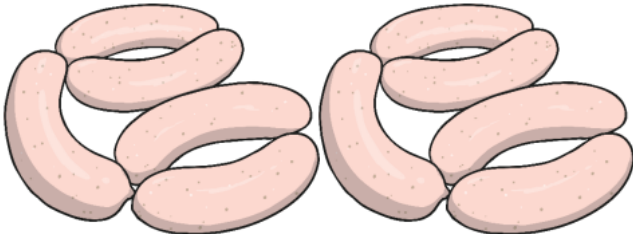

If you had 10 sausages in a pack and you have cooked 4 of them, how many sausages would you have left in the packet?



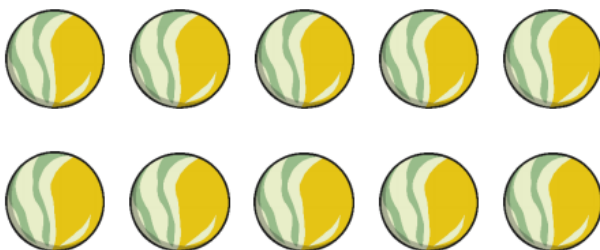

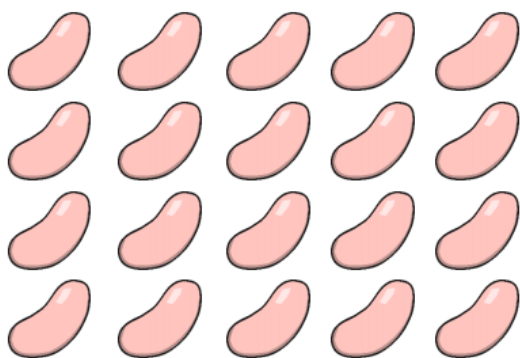
If you had 10 marbles and 2 of them rolled away, how many would you have left?
