You will need:

- 10 small objects for counting
- 2 plates placed next to each other

Listen to a grown-up read the number problem, then put the correct number of objects on each plate.

Count the objects on both plates to find out how many objects you have **altogether**.

1. Mrs Crossley puts 3 biscuits on Mrs Dexter's plate. She puts 2 biscuits on Miss Jones' plate. How many biscuits are there altogether? Write the number in this box.	2. There are 5 peas left on Daisy's plate. There is 1 pea on Daisy's mum's plate. How many peas are there altogether? Write the number in this box.
3. Daddy Bear loves grapes! He puts 4 on his plate and gives 4 to Mummy Bear. How many grapes are there altogether? Write the number in this box.	4. Miss Kiernan puts 6 chocolates on her plate, then puts 3 chocolates on Marble's plate. How many chocolates are there altogether? Write the number in this box.
5. Sophie's mum gives Sophie 3 buns. She gives the tiger 7 buns! How many buns are there altogether? Write the number in this box.	<u>6. Clever Cats Challenge:</u> You have 10 sweets. Can you share the sweets between the two plates and tell your own number story? Ask your grown-up if they can work out how many sweets there are altogether.
