Enjoy searching for them and let us know how many you spotted!

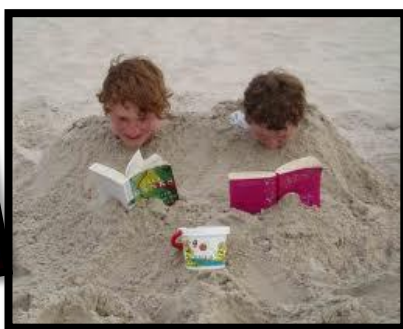
