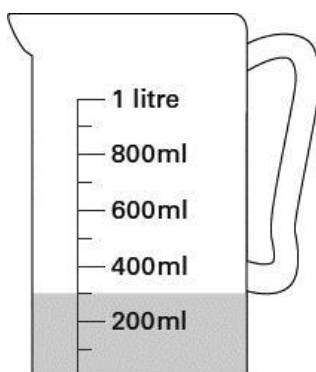

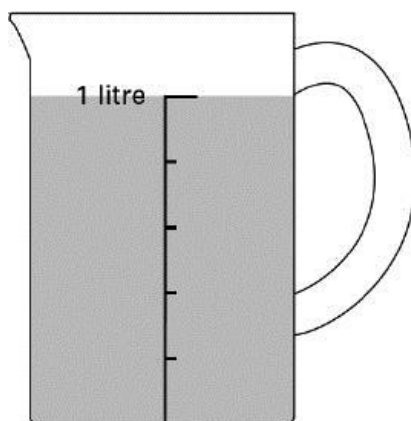

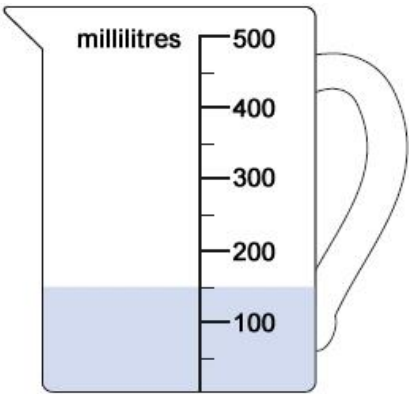
Lauren **pours out** 400 millilitres of water.

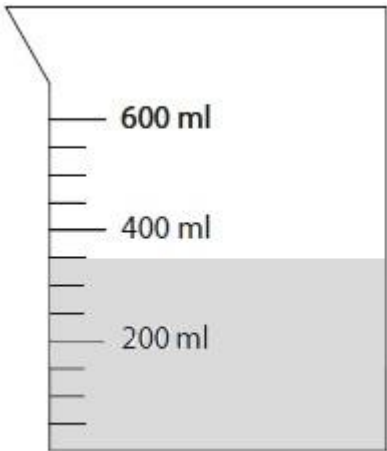

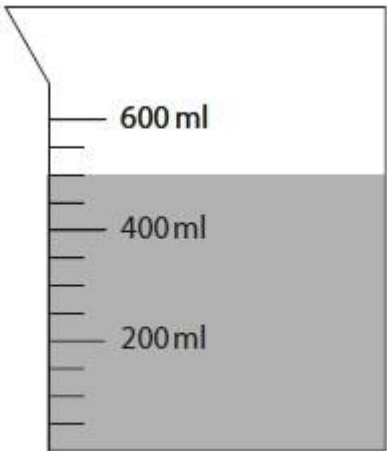

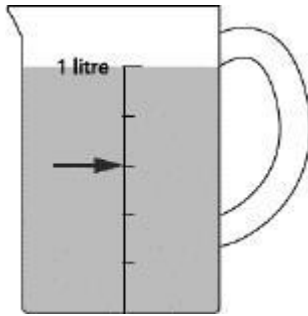
