Science

- We are starting our Topic on Materials, States of Matter and Changes, this topic will take us all the way to the end of the Year.
- I am giving you all of the Science Tasks in one go now and you can decide how you want to work through some of the activities until the end of term.
- I have split the pack into 2 sections: Part A includes a lot of tasks and activities to help develop confidence and understanding in the key concepts needed and Part B is full of fun experiments based on this topic and all themed around the books of Roald Dahl - I hope you enjoy them!
- One way to work through the packs could be to complete some tasks in Pack A over the first couple of weeks and then move onto Pack B or you could do one task from Part A followed by one experiment activity in Part B - The choice is yours but please don't try to do them all at once!
