

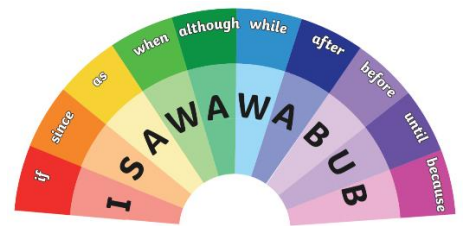
Writing - Kindness

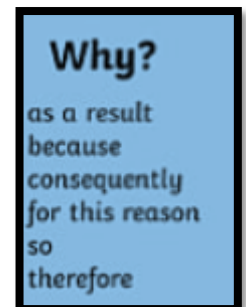
Writing task 1 - We are all wonders

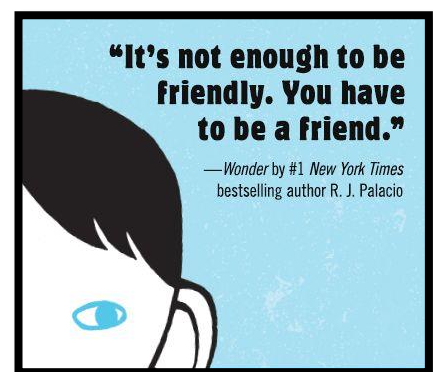
Writing task 2 - Going to school
