Milk in School Policy 2024

Gawber Primary School will provide milk in school for all pupils requesting milk within the guidelines outlined in this policy.

- . All pupils under the age of 5 receive milk free of charge and this is fully funded from the Department of Health.
- . The school must also provide milk free of charge to pupils eligible to receive free school meals.
- . All other Primary aged pupils who wish to join the scheme can do so and the charge is currently 31p per day payable at the beginning of each term depending on the number of days in each term.
- . The scheme is subsidised by the European Union and the school should not profit from the scheme.
- . Parents are required to order milk directly from Cool Milk.
- . Parents will need to register by logging into www.coolmilk.com
- .
- . They will need a valid email address to do so along with their child's school name and class details.
- . Parents will be given the option to pay for the coming term or for the entire school year.
- . Full details and FAQ can be found on the school milk website.
- . All milk pre-ordered for by parents will be delivered to school on a daily basis.
- . Class lists will be sent to the school on a Wednesday showing who is eligible to receive milk for the following week.
