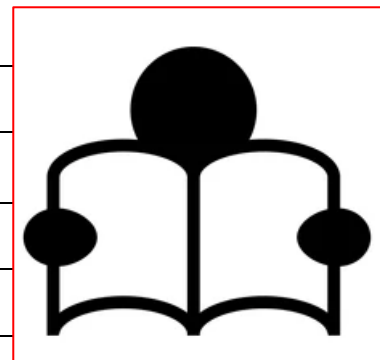

	Speaking and listening
EYFS	Children repeat the basic greeting 'hola.'
Year 1	- Children say basic greetings for good morning/good afternoon. - Children can say hello and goodbye. - Children can count to 6.
Year 2	- Children can say the days of the week. - Children can say some colours. - Children can count to 10.
Year 3	- Children can repeat familiar words and short phrases. - Children can ask and answer pre learned questions from memory.
Year 4	- Children can produce short pre -prepared phrases on a familiar topic. - Children can take part in a short dialogue with at least two exchanges.
Year 5	- Children can produce extended sentences about a familiar topic. - Children can take part in an exchange with at least 3 exchanges responding appropriately.
Year 6	- Children can use complex sentences with detailed information independently, sometimes from memory. - Children can present to an audience in Spanish using correct pronunciation and intonation. - Children can take part in short conversations, adapting these successfully.



Reading

EYFS	Children recognise when a word is written in a different language.
Year 1	Children can make links between images/actions and basic greetings.
Year 2	- Children make links between images of words, colours, days of the week and the words that match these. - Children make links between numbers and the words related to these.
Year 3	Children can read some familiar written words.
Year 4	Children can read and understand some familiar short phrases.
Year 5	Children can read and understand short simple texts in different contexts.
Year 6	Children can read and understand short texts that include extended and complex sentences.



Writing

Year 3	Children can write familiar words and some short phrases with accuracy.
Year 4	Children can write a simple sentence accurately.
Year 5	Children can write a short text about a familiar topic with accuracy.
Year 6	Children can write an extended text on more than one topic including unfamiliar words sourced from a dictionary where necessary.
