Have fun exploring the activities below:



Tasty Treat! Cook or Bake an Easter or Spring tasty treat - Don't forget to write down the ingredients and method and take a picture before you eat it all!	Egg Basket! Design and make an Easter Egg basket made out of coloured strips of paper and / or straws. You can also use sticky tape and glue to hold it together. How many eggs can your basket hold?	Easter Hat! Make an Easter Hat. An Easter Bonnet is any new or fancy hat traditionally worn at Easter. You can either add Easter/Spring themed items to an old hat or create a hat from scratch.
Design your own Easter Egg! Either draw and decorate an egg or make an egg to decorate.	Easter A-Z! Create an A-Z list all about Easter	Egg Tower! Build a plastic egg 3D tower. How tall can you make yours?
Egg Drop! Have a go at the classic egg drop. Can you drop an egg without breaking it? Pick a height and use materials you have at home to help protect the egg before the drop.	Famous Rabbits! We have all heard of the Easter Bunny, but what about other famous rabbits? Find out about another famous rabbit and write about why they are famous and where their character comes from. Draw a picture to help illustrate your report.	Spinning Eggs! Using a plastic egg and a surface of your choice, measure how long you can keep you egg spinning for. How could you get your egg to spin for longer? How about changing the surface? Changing the type or size of egg?
No Eggs! Write some alternatives to giving Easter Eggs as gifts at Easter.	What's the Question? Write 10 questions with 'Chocolate' as the answer.	Maths! Use Easter chocolate and sweets as Maths manipulatives.
Night, Night! The Easter Bunny is going to be tired after all his Easter antics! Design and build a bed for the Easter Bunny using any materials you find at home.	Bunny Bridge! Build a bridge for the Easter Bunny to help him make it to his beloved carrot! The bridge has to be made out of pennies and be 3cm high and wide!	Egg Roll! How well do eggs roll? Try racing plastic eggs, chocolate eggs or hard boiled eggs. Try them down ramps at different angles. What do you notice?
Recycled Rabbit! Create a rabbit or any other spring animal out of recycled materials found at home.	What an Artist! Draw or paint an Easter Picture. Be creative. Why not try using a new technique?	Spring Chicken! Research the life cycle of a chicken. Can you present your findings in an interesting way?

Polygon Egg! Draw a 2D Easter egg using a range of polygons (2D Shapes). How many different ways can you use these to create an egg shape? Try using triangles, quadrilaterals, pentagons, hexagons etc. If you have completed this challenge, why not try drawing a symmetrical egg too?	Team Games! Split into 2 or more teams. Each team has 3 minutes to write as many words as possible out of the letters found in HAPPY EASTER. The team with most words win. Continue team work fun by playing an Easter game of Pictionary, charades or team relay races too!	Bubble Fun! Explore blowing bubbles and creating your own bubble wand and mixture. Which makes the best bubble? Which bubble lasts longest? What's the biggest bubble you can make? Can you catch a bubble?
Easter! Create a Palm Cross and other items which represent the different days and events of Holy Week/ Easter Week.	Egg Car! Make your egg move by turning it into a car! What will work well as the wheels? Make more than one and have a race!	My Home Rainbow! Create a rainbow collage/image by collecting coloured materials/objects from your garden or home.
Has Spring Sprung? Look outside, Can you see how the trees and plants are changing? What flowers can you see? Draw a picture or write down the evidence to show that Spring is here.	Spring Author! Have a go at becoming a Spring Author. Write a Poem, Story, Report, Play, Comic Strip or Joke based on Easter or Spring. Can you make a book to 'publish' your writing in?	Spring into Action! Create a game to be played indoors or outdoors which helps kids and adults stay physically active. How can it be linked to Easter or Spring?
Rubber Egg! Can you make an egg bounce? Use vinegar, a cup and an egg to make you rubber egg. Make it an experiment by using another item like a lime that also has a 'shell' - What happens? https://www.coolkidfacts.com/how-to-make-a-rubber-egg/	As much use as a Chocolate Teapot! Think up some silly products, such as a Chocolate teapot. How many silly items can you design? Why not design a shop to sell all these silly things in? How would you advertise them? Who would want to buy them?	Egg Catapult! Use materials on hand to build a catapult that will launch a small plastic egg (or a chocolate egg if you are feeling brave!). How far does it go? How could you make it go further?
Hide and Seek! If you were the Easter Bunny, where would you hide the eggs? Brainstorm the best hiding places for Easter Eggs.	Zip Wire! Design and/ or Build a harness to safely transport a small chocolate egg down a zip wire! String, wool, pipe cleaners and other items may be useful for this task!	It's Party Time! Design and make Easter/Spring decorations for your house. Maybe you could make bunting, paper chains or paper flowers? Why not plan and throw a party for your family in your newly decorated house? Have fun!
