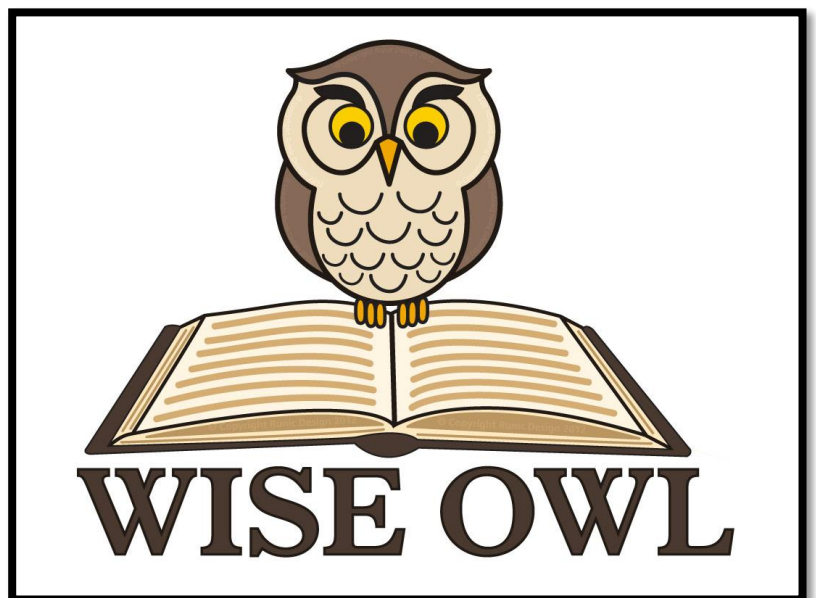


Dear Class 5,
