Task 1

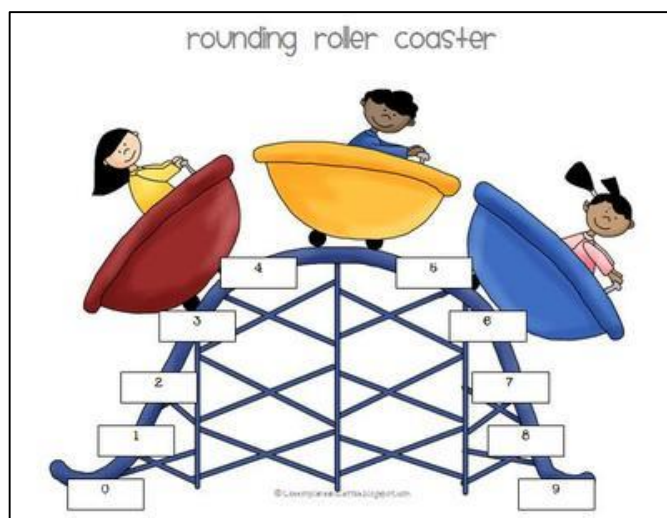
This week we are going to flashback to our knowledge about ROUNDING! This is something that we looked at in the Autumn Term.
