Royal Family Tree

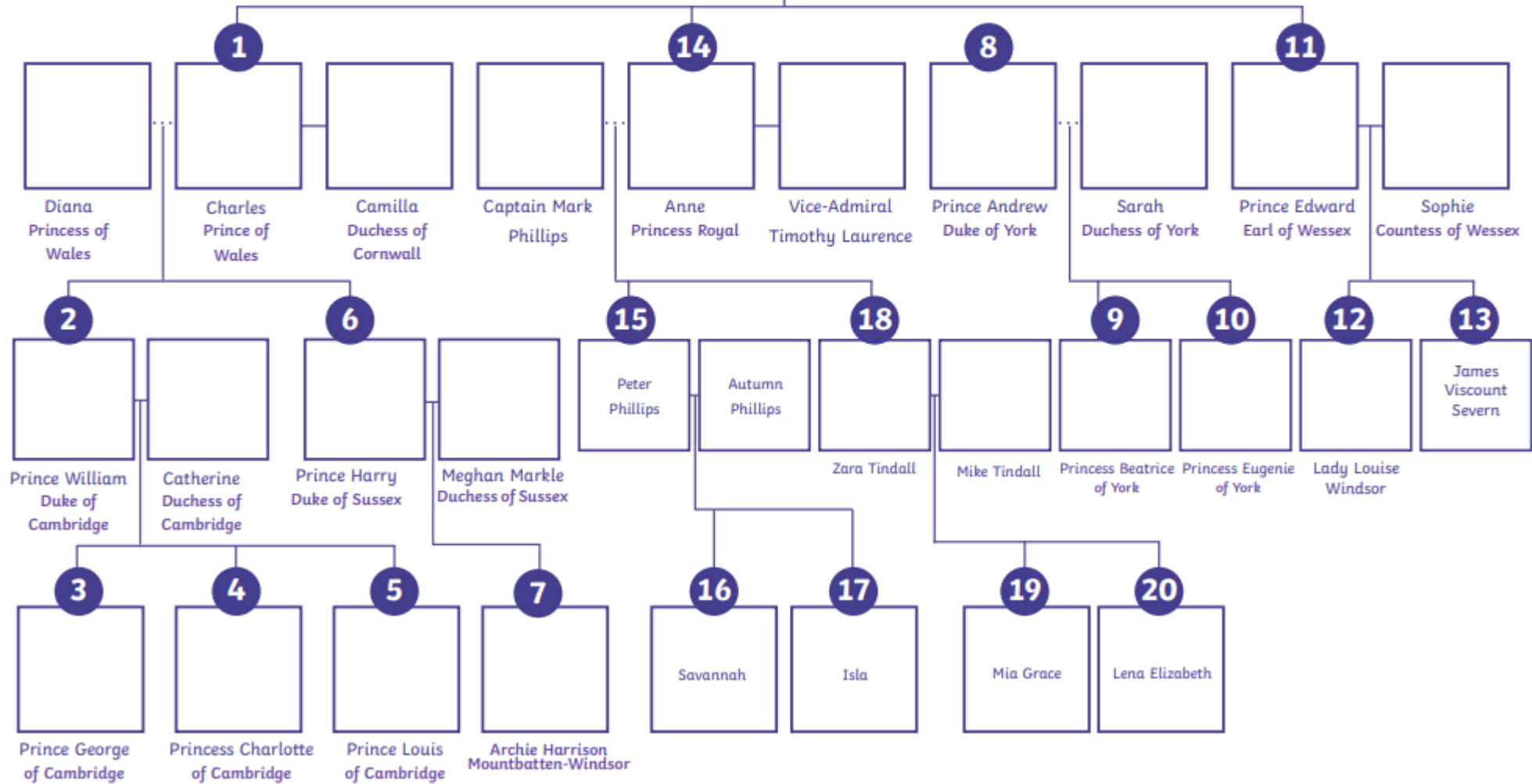


Key

The youngest British monarch at the start her reign was Mary, Queen of Scots, who became queen when she was only 6 days old, in 1542.

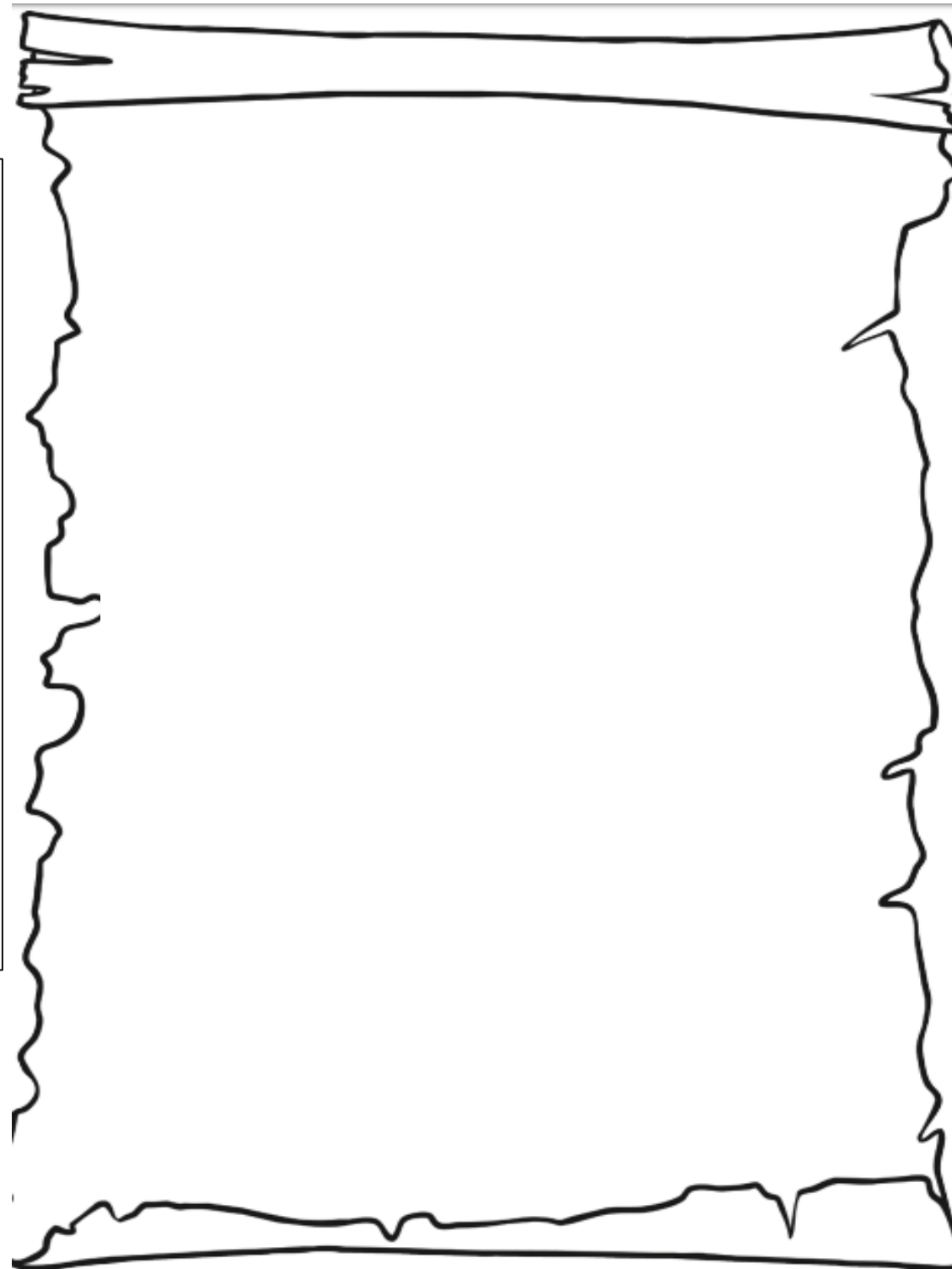
Challenge
