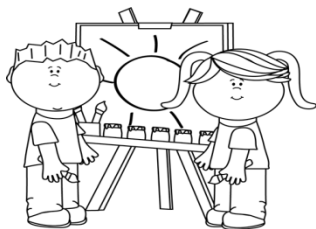

Verbs ending in 'ed'
