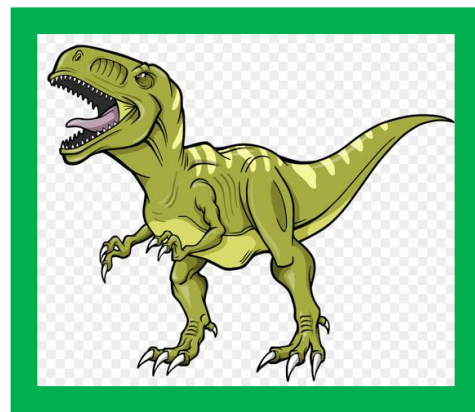


Hello Class 5,

The activities for this week are all themed around a new topic ...
DINOSAURS!

Every day, you should be aiming to do some maths, some reading, some writing and some topic. The tasks are labelled 'task 1,' 'task 2' etc. This means that on the first day of the week (Monday) you should try to complete task 1 for each subject. On the next day (Tuesday) you should try to complete all the task 2 activities and so on.



You may have already established a routine at home that is working for you and your parents. If you have, keep it up! However, after speaking with a few of you, I realised that some of Class 5 were needing a little guidance as to what should be completed and when.

Here is an example of how a timetable could look...

	Maths		Reading	Writing		Topic
Monday	Start with the first Oak National Academy lesson. Once you have completed this, you could do 'dino-challenge 1' from the activities that have been uploaded to our class web page. To really challenge yourself, you could then have a go at the White Rose maths lesson 1. (The White Rose tasks are additional...but worth doing!).	Take a little break	Look at the first piece of reading material and answer the task 1 questions. These will link to the writing tasks so it is helpful to complete the reading task first.	Complete writing task 1 following reading task 1, using the information you have got from the reading task to help you.	Take a little break	Complete the first topic task (Geography) using the internet to help you.

Try to make sure you have regular breaks to give your brain chance to recover from all of the hard work you are doing. Then, move onto a different task.

These are just guidelines of course. Your own routine might be slightly different but this should give you an idea of how much you should be doing each day.
