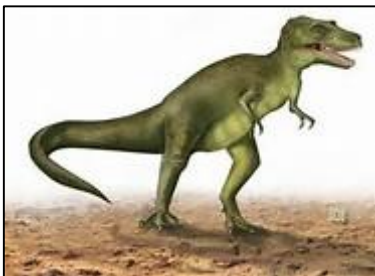


T-REX

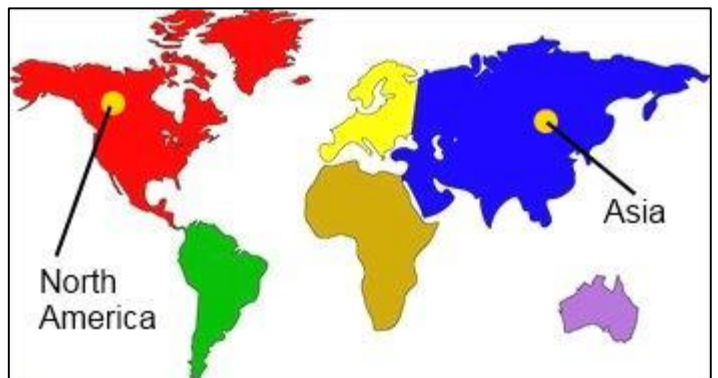
What did a T-Rex eat?

Paleontologists from the United States and Canada have found bite marks on the giants' bones that they believe were made by another T. rex!

Where did the T-Rex live?

Up until recently, it was thought that the T- Rex lived only in North America and Asia. However, scientists have recently discovered a hipbone belonging to an ancestor of Tyrannosaurus Rex. They found it at Dinosaur Cove in Victoria, Australia.

This amazing discovery leads them to believe that the Tyrannosaurs may have lived all over the world - and that more Tyrannosaurus remains (or skeletons) may be discovered in Africa, South America and India. North America and Asia.
