If something is alive it **must** do all of the seven things listed below.
If it does not do all of the seven things listed below it is not alive.

Move - It must be able to move. All living things can move. Plants, flowers and trees can move too to face the sunshine or light.

Respire - This is a posh word for breathing. All living things can breathe. We breathe in oxygen and breathe out carbon dioxide and plants breathe in our carbon dioxide and breathe out oxygen.

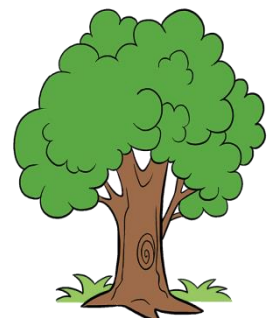
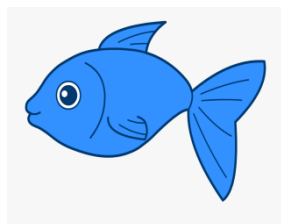
Senses - All living things have at least one sense. Not all living things have 5 senses like us.

Nutrition - This is a grown up word to mean that all living things need to be able to eat and drink.
