

Phonics

Please continue with your daily phonics sessions. If you search for 'Read Write Inc' on YouTube, the phonics scheme we follow is currently providing daily lessons which your children can watch and take part in. The lessons are split into Set 1 Speed Sounds and Set 2 Speed Sounds. Follow the lessons that match your child's current learning. The lessons are updated daily and then deleted, so it is a good idea to make time every day to learn a new sound. Children will need a pencil and paper before they start the sessions, so they can practise writing new sounds and words.

On Tuesdays and Thursdays, we would also do 'Set 1 Spelling' and 'Set 2 Spelling' sessions. These are also available on YouTube.

Please also keep practising reading and writing the 'red' sight words **I of my to the no, you, your and said**. If your children are confident with these, learn the words **are** and **be**.

On Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, we would normally listen to your child read their Read Write Inc books. There are some free ebooks available here if you follow the link:

Literacy

This week's traditional tale is 'The 3 little Pigs'. A special guest is reading our story this week, please find the video on our Class Dojo Page. I wonder who it can be ?

Monday (10 minutes)

Introduce the new story and watch it together. Ask your child to listen carefully to the story. Hope you enjoyed our special guest reading the story!

When the story is finished, ask the following questions:

Which characters are in the story ?

What are the 3 little pigs houses made of ?

What words does the wolf keep saying ?

What happens to the wolf at the end ?

Tuesday (10 minutes)

Today we are looking at ordering (sequencing) the story. Watch the video again or read your own version of the story if you need to. Show the 3 pictures from the story. Which goes at the beginning? Which comes next? Does this one go at the end? Can you say a sentence to go with each picture to retell the story?

Wednesday (10 minutes)

Can you use the puppets to act out the story. Ask them.....What happens first? What happens next? What happens at the end? Hope you have fun!

Thursday (10-15 minutes)

Today we are going to draw 3 pictures to retell the story of 'The 3 little pigs'. Talk about what happens at the beginning. What could you draw? (Use the pictures from Tuesday if they need help) What happens in the middle? Talk about what they could draw. What happens at the end?

Pick one of their pictures and see if they could think of a sentence. Repeat the sentence. Count the words, and show them you writing it.

Friday (10 minutes)

Today we are going to write sentences to retell the story. Look at the story board from yesterday. Can you think of a sentence to go with the first picture? Repeat the sentence. Count how many words.

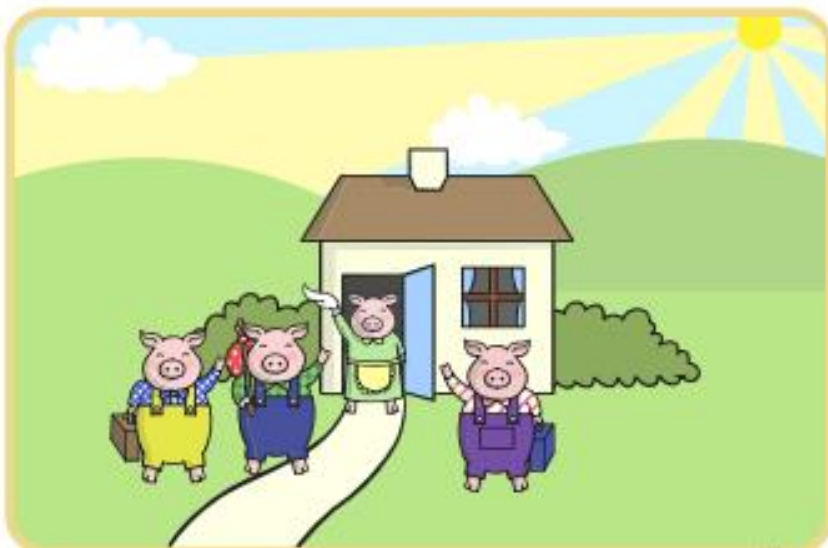
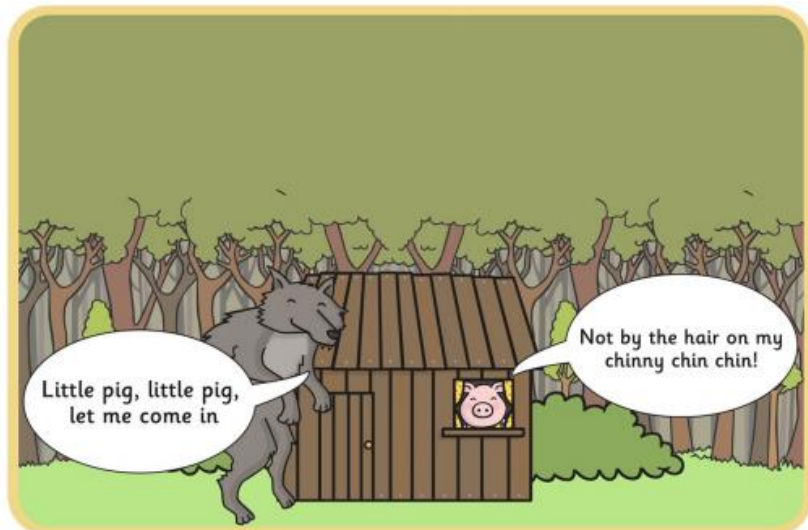
Remind the children about our writing rule 'We always start a sentence with a capital letter, we need a finger space between our words and to stop the writing running away, don't forget the full stop'

Repeat for each picture.

Challenge: Can they read their story back to you?
