On the first day. Just let your child listen to it.... ask them every couple of pages.... what do you think might happen next? Were they right?

Let them re-listen to it as often as possible throughout the week. Can they retell you the story by looking at the pictures? Can you write down sentences they tell you about the picture, remember to sound out each word and remind them of finger spaces and a full stop.

Can they answer these questions by the end of the week?

- Can you remember the different kinds of eggs?
- What did the chick give the rabbit?
- How did the rabbit help the mouse?
- What woke the rabbit up?
- Can you remember what animals were in the story?

*Go on a spring walk. What can you find?

*Watch the chick hatching (Mute the sound and talk about what is happening)

*Do an Easter egg hunt around the house, with your paper eggs. Number them on the back. Can they collect them in order? Time how long it takes.

* This week in Maths we were learning to tell the time - o'clock and half past. What can you do in a minute? Time yourself doing different things.

*Draw a picture about a story you have heard. Can you write a sentence or two?

*Can you label a picture of a chick?
