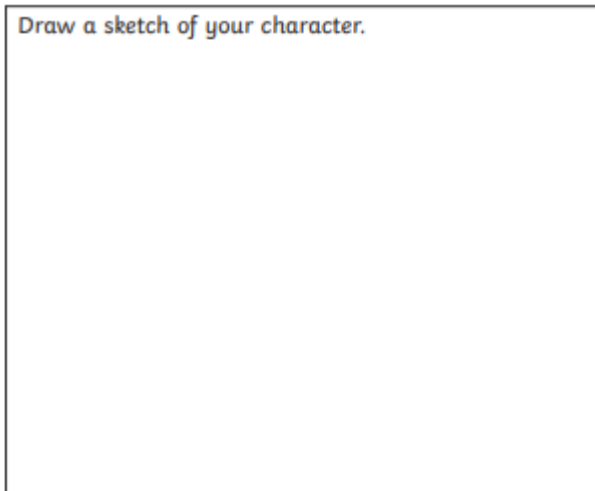

- Exclamation marks
- Question Marks
