

Sound Wave Picture

You will be making a scrape art picture to depict sound waves.

What you need:

- Paper x 2
- Coloured wax crayons
- Black Poster Paint
- A stick (cocktail/skewer)
- A recording of a song or music

What to do:

- 1) Using the wax crayons, colour thick vertical stripes in different colours on one of your pieces of paper.
- 2) Cover all of the paper and colour with a thick layer of black paint.
- 3) Leave to dry (you might have to leave it for a day).
- 4) Pick a section from your piece of music that has high and low pitch in it. Have a go at drawing the sound waves to match the music on the second piece of paper. Remember, low sounds and the waves are further apart, high sounds, the waves are close together. Keep practising until you're happy with it.
- 5) Using your cocktail stick or skewer, scrape off the dry black paint to match your sound wave. You can use anything sharp to do this but please be careful and make sure an adult is there to help you.
