Hello Terrific Tigers,

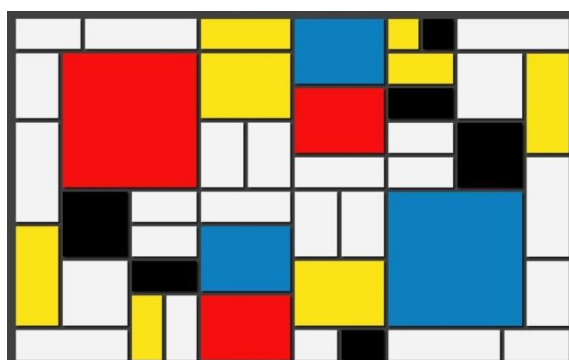
I hope you had a lot of fun last week and got to do lots of fantastic things!

I know that you enjoyed writing your quest myths so thought you would enjoy these lessons on The Oak National Academy.
