

A Dragon's Nest

Make your very own dragon eggs that you could place in a nest. Follow the instructions to make your very own dragon's eggs using papier mâché.



You will need:

- balloons
- newspaper (or scrap paper)
- glue
- water
- a brush
- paint

How to make your eggs:

1. Tear the newspaper into small strips.
2. Mix glue with a little water in a bowl to make a watery paste.
3. Blow up a balloon to the size that you would like your egg (don't make it too big or it may pop!)
4. Carefully, place strips of newspaper into the bowl of paste and then stick them onto the balloon. Use a brush to smooth it on if needed.
5. Cover the whole balloon with one layer of paper and glue then allow it to dry.
6. Once dry, glue another layer of paper on the balloon and allow to dry. Add at least two more layers of paper and glue.
7. When the paper is completely dry, burst the balloon carefully and remove from inside.
8. Paint your egg. What colour do you think a dragon's egg would be?

Once you have mastered using papier mâché to make your egg, you could make a whole nest! How many eggs will be in your dragon's nest?
