Top tips when writing

- Use careful handwriting leads/joined
- Use careful spellings using your phonic knowledge/dictionary
- Use a clear capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop to punctuate your sentences.
- Try writing in multi-clause sentences using conjunctions.
- Try adding descriptive detail using adjectives, how adverbs (ly) and similes.
- Try to use commas in lists, exclamation marks and question marks correctly.



Science

Your science work this week is based on habitats. The following are suggested activities to complete:

- Finish your habitat shoe box.
- Then write about the habitat you have created (talk about the animals that live there, the plants, the climate and any other interesting information)
- Research what the animals eat and food chains that exist there. Then draw some simple diagrams to show some of the food chains.
